## RIGHTS AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

RIGHTS project aims to identify, implement and test a didactic methodology that can help:

- promoting Global Citizenship Education in the EU secondary schools curriculum;
- delivering innovative ICT-based tools to enhance teaching and learning thus fostering initiative, innovation and, creativity;
- allowing teachers and students to acquire new skills through the production of Digital Stories;
- empowering students stimulating their creativity and critical thinking.

## RIGHTS DIDACTIC METHODOLOGY

The innovative aspect of RIGHTS didactic methodology is to use a digital storytelling approach to Global Citizenship, thus enhancing a new learning approach based on interactive teaching that stimulates digital competences, as well as social and civic competences and cultural awareness and expression.

#### TARGET GROUPS

RIGHTS project addresses European high school teachers and students through the following key actions:

- Bringing new digital tools into the classroom to empower teachers to experiment with new technology and render teaching and learning more up-to-date and interesting.
- Encouraging teachers to work together with their students to create and produce their digital stories on EGC, allowing them to discover new ways to approach digital education and to be more active and aware as European and "global" citizens.

#### RIGHTS EXPERIMENTATION

The main project result is the RIGHTS pilot course delivered in two parts:

- E-learning course for teachers, focusing on Global Citizenship Education and on Digital Storytelling as a tool in Education.
- Workshops where teachers and students produce their digital stories related to EGC's topics.
